Contemplate on the traditional! Walk with warriors of the Masai, hunt with **Hadzabe Bushmen**, learn from their long-established wildlife experience in the bush. Walking with Alex or another experienced guide you will notice we actively endeavor to conserve a genuine environment. A raw product not manufactured experience, full of plastic fixed alternatives. A four day walking safari combined with five nights in **Serian's Serengeti Maswa** is what its all about. A unadulterated bush experience with those that know and understand it!



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We have an **exclusive use conservation area of 250,000 acres** with access to over 1,500,000 more; this is a classic walking area. Game trails weave their way around this area and traditional migratory routes are well trodden at this time of year. To the south is Lake Eyasi home of the Hadzabe bushman. Cousins of the Kalahari bushmen with centuries of bush craft at their fingers. A significant area is only accessible by foot and this is how safaris are conducted here. You will immediately notice the difference between a vehicle tour and one conducted on foot. Senses that may have been a little dulled in a car will strain to perceive indications of the wild game that surrounds you. Your perception of the bush will change until you feel an intimate relationship with the environment itself.



Arrive at “**Serian’s Serengeti Maswa**” a handsome traditional bush camp in the Maswa Game Reserve. Having the chance to orient yourself and prepare for three nights exploration in the company of the bushman hunter the “Hadzabe”.

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A stroll south through the acacia woodland dominated by great “kopjes”, passing through herds of wildebeest and zebra will loosen the muscles. Hiking in Africa is often perceived as hard work but in reality it is just trundling along reacting to whatever interesting sightings pass under your nose! A shopping spree littered with interesting finds, dung beetles rolling along on their balls of elephant dung, impala bounding through the bush and diminutive dikdik scooting into the safety of the nearest bush.



A phenomenal game area Maswa Game Reserve has significant populations of Elephant, Lion, Leopard, Giraffe, Buffalo, and plains game. Unusual species include lesser kudu, side striped hyena and caracal, and tracking is easy in the rich alluvial soil. “Walking with Warrior’s” you will learn how to track, harvest honey, light fires the real way, make bows and arrows and stalk silently to short distances of your prey.

Sleeping out under the stars, the skies appear iridescent sparkling galaxies of stars, great consciousness can be made of this in the company of traditional astronomers. Follow the spoor of an Impala ram in the early morning and track it step by step through its daily routine. Scrounging up fresh acacia pods, alarmed by the leopard, scratching its itchy horns on the trees nearby until there! There he is! Proud horns spiral into the air, an alarm bark and he stands stock-still. Three hours of tracking rewarded by a close glimpse, magnificent! Satisfying the soul.





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A three to four day hike can bring you to the shores of Lake Eyasi, through the dramatic gorges that line the escarpment of the Great Rift Valley. In the company of porters, Hadzabe Hunters and your guide you will explore the wild bush of the escarpment. The hunters will help teach you to light fires, rudimentary use of a bow and arrow, collection and use of herbs, traditional cures and traditional folklore.



Porters will carry the camp equipment and you will seem to be part of the early exploratory trade caravans of old. Complete comfort albeit basic. The pace will not be hard but basic fitness is a must, those that want to push themselves will be afforded every opportunity with competitive warriors at hand this can be quite stimulating for those in search of wild fitness. After a few nights out you will be raking the horizon through experienced eyes, out across the savannah towards the famed Ngorongoro Crater. A car will pick you up and return you to the comfort of Serengeti Maswa and the next few days of adventure. Strategically located on the edge of the Serengeti plains in the heart of the Maswa Game Reserve Mara it is a prime time game area and ideally placed to witness the remarkable migration birthing season!
